EVANGELISM TRAINING

Evangelism is simply the act of sharing the gospel to others.
All followers of Jesus are called to evangelism, not just pastors and missionaries. Thus we all have a role to play in the great commission to make disciples of all nations.

Many people do not evangelize because they do not feel equipped to do so, they might be afraid, or many are not sure where to begin. In the following pages you'll find a list of statistics from a recent study where 1,600 Christians were surveyed and asked what were the hurdles in sharing their faith. If you relate to some of these responses, our hope is that this resource will help you overcome those obstacles.

This training material was created so that the body of Christ would feel more equipped to share the gospel in any and every situation. We will not go over every evangelism strategy but we have included a few strategies and techniques that we hope will help you to feel better equipped and empowered to share your faith with those around you.






WHAT PREVENTS YOU FROM SHARING YOUR FAITH?



22% SAID THAT FEAR WAS THE LEADING CAUSE.






THE 3 CIRCLES

The 3 Circles guide was designed to help Christians share their faith by incorporating this simple illustration. This tool provides a method of turning everyday conversations about brokenness into everyday conversations about Christ. The goal of '3 Circles' is to equip Christians to share their faith with non-Christians.

This tool helps Christians to share the gospel using just three simple circles. These circles represent the three main themes.

- (1) God's Design
- (2) Brokenness / Sin
- (3) The Gospel / Salvation in Jesus

They also illustrate how accepting and submitting to Jesus will grow your faith and lead to God's perfect design. All you need to have is a pen and paper, or napkin, or hand!

EXPLAINED

STEP 1 - Draw a circle and label it "Brokenness". Draw several squiggly arrows out from it and looping back to 'Brokenness'. We are trying to show no matter what we do it just boomerangs back to brokenness.

STEP 2 - On the left, draw a second circle, and write "God's Design" above.

STEP 3 - Draw an arrow from God's Design to Brokenness and label it "Sin".

STEP 4 - Draw a third circle below and between the first two (forming an upside-down triangle of circles), and write "Jesus" above it.

STEP 5 - Draw a line from Brokenness to Jesus, draw a king's crown and writeTurn and Believe (or follow).

STEP 6 - Draw a line from Jesus to God's Design and label it "Restored."

STEP 7 - Draw a line from God's Design to Brokenness and write "Go" above it.


THE GOSPEL BRIDGE

Romans 6:23 can be used to share the gospel clearly and effectively using the words in the verse along side a simple illustration.

- 1. Draw 2 cliffs opposite of each other.
- 2. Draw a stick figure on one side and write GOD on the other.
- 3. Explain that there is no way to get to the other side on your own.
- 4. Read the verse Romans 6:23.
- 5. Explain that our sin separated us from God, and the wages of that sin is death.
- 6. Draw a cross and write Christ Jesus on the cross.
- 7 Explain that Jesus paid for our sins and we can accept his payment and have reconciliation with God through Jesus by making Him Lord of our life.

ROMANS 6:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.



PERSONAL TESTIMONY

Your testimony is the story of how Jesus' love, sacrifice, and saving grace has fully redeemed your life. Your story — regardless of how "spectacular" or "ordinary" you think it is — it is a story about God's character and redemption. It is your eyewitness account of how God rescued you from sin and death through Christ, and changed your life as a result.

Your story is God's story, it is the Gospel of Jesus' saving grace in your life. It wasn't a small thing; you went from death to life! The main thing to remember is that this is the story of how the Lord saved your life. He didn't just save your life "that one time", he saved your life for eternity. This is great news that we get to share with others and ultimately give them the chance to accept salvation from Jesus as well.

When it comes to using your testimony as a form of evangelism, we must make the focus on Jesus. It was nothing that we did to save ourselves. We must also remember that there was a time that we did not know the gospel and at some point, someone shared with us the good news of Jesus. now we get to be that person for someone else.
